## COMMITTEE ON GOVERNANCE AND LONG-RANGE PLANNING MINUTES OF MEETING VOLUME GLRP 33

## February 22, 2019

A meeting of the Committee on Governance and Long-Range Planning was held in Room 206, The Penn Stater Hotel and Conference Center, State College, Pennsylvania, on February 22, 2019.
