[^0]:    ${ }^{1}$ The Faculty Senate Report discussed the adoption of "three-by-three-by-three" meetings each semester among the leadership and executive staff of the Board, the Faculty, and the University. For example, at the University of Minnesota, this $3 \times 3 \times 3$ structure consists of: (1) the Board Chair, Vice-Chair, and Executive Director, (2) The Chair of the Faculty Senate's Faculty Consultative Committee (the "FCC"), the FCC's Vice-Chair and Secretary to the Faculty, and (3) the President, Provost, and President's Chief of Staff. These meetings would facilitate communications among the various groups responsible for efficient university governance.
