RESOLVED, That pending adoption of a new budget to reflect clarification of the amount and form of the State Appropriation, and subsequent decisions regarding the amount of tuition charges, adjustments to salaries, wages and employee benefits, and provisions for fuel and utilities and other const increases, the Board of Trustees approves continuation for the interim period beginning July 1, 2022, total budget amounts at the level of the adjusted 2021-22 budget as follows:
